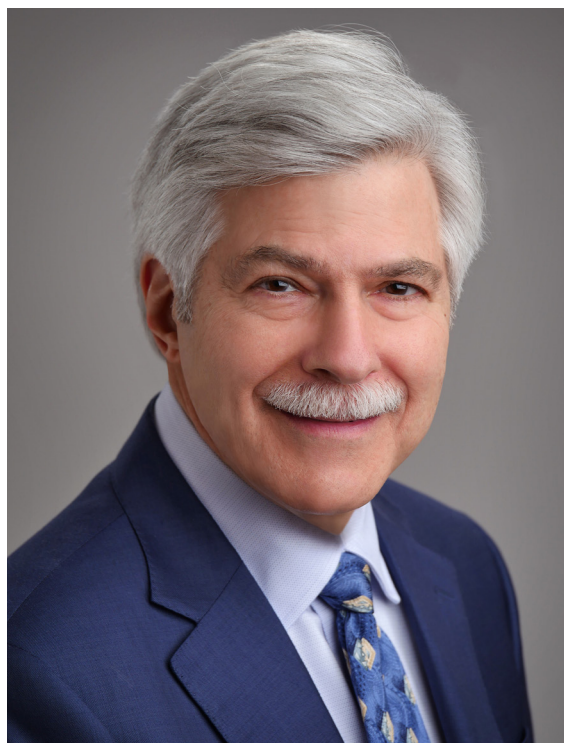
This success story reflects ECG Academy's broader mission to provide accessible, expert-led ECG education that empowers learners to think critically, recognize subtle findings,
